A regular council meeting of the Lake City Council was brought to order by the honorable Mayor Cameron Tate.

The meeting opened with a prayer and the pledge of allegiance.

The roll having been called and the following councilmembers answered their names: BRENDA HUTCHESON, KATE WELLS, KASEY EAKINS, HARMONY CASH, JAKE EMERY, JAY DAVIS. The meeting continued with the above members and the city clerk Lisa Sitz present.

A motion by Councilmember Hutcheson and seconded by Councilmember Cash to add two things to the agenda, Ordinance No. 326-24 and appropriating reimbursement money from ARDOT. Motion passed (6/0).

A motion by Councilmember Cash and seconded by Councilmember Emery to accept the minutes as written from council meeting held May 2, 2024. Motion passed (6/0).

A motion by Councilmember Cash and seconded by Councilmember Wells to accept the minutes as written from the council meeting held May 20, 2024. Motion passed (6/0).

Mayor Tate discussed the financial statements.

The Lake City Volunteer Fire Dept. received two (2) applications for volunteers. Fire Chief Hunter Timms approved. The 2 applicants were Micah Hogan and Coby McClung Blagg. A motion by Councilmember Hutcheson and seconded by Councilmember Emery to accept both applicants to the Lake City Volunteer Fire Dept. Motion passed (6/0).

Mayor Tate discussed with the council about terminating the blue bag recycling program. He explained to the council the changes that had been made if continuing the program. A motion by councilmember Emery and seconded by Councilmember Davis to terminate the blue bag recycling program. Motion passed (6/0).

The new garbage truck the city has ordered was originally a Kenworth. Due to conflict with delivery, the city will be getting a Peterbilt, and they will honor the original bid.

The city received reimbursement money back from ARDOT for paving that did not get done. A motion by Councilmember Hutcheson and seconded by Councilmember Eakins to appropriate \$55,000 back into the Sales tax Street improvement. Motion passed (6/0).

A motion by Councilmember Cash and seconded by Councilmember Emery to read the 1st reading of Ordinance No. 326-24 by title only. Motion passed (6/0).

A motion by Councilmember Eakins and seconded by Councilmember Emery to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously.
